1-2	Topic Sentence: <u>general statement, overview of what your P is proving. BIG IDEA</u>
1-2	Example # 1: <u>Start with transition Support, prove, provide evidence that the claim in your TS is true.</u>
2-3	Explanation # 1: <u>Starts with descriptive word/verb. explains example one, and tells <u>HOW</u> it proves the TS.</u>
1-2	Example # 2: <u>Starts with transition Support, prove, provide evidence that claim in your TS is true.</u>
2-3	Explanation # 2: <u>Starts with descriptive word, explain example two, and tells <u>HOW</u> example two proves TS.</u>
1-2	Example # 3: <u>Starts with transition Support, prove, provide evidence that your TS is true.</u>
2-3	Explanation # 3: <u>Starts with descriptive verb/word, explains only example three & tells <u>how</u> it proves the TS.</u>
1-2	Conclusion: <u>Restates, rephrases, represents your TS in different words. BIG IDEA</u>

- Rules to remember:
- No 1st person - EVER
 - no → I, me, my, we, etc.
 - No "you" - no addressing the reader
 - OK → ONESELF, PEOPLE, PERSON, SOCIETY, SOMEONE
 - No contractions - don't → do not
 - transitions - for example, for instance, moreover, furthermore, in addition, therefore
 - No in conclusion
 - descriptive words - express, describe, depict, explains, shows, portray
